# Airline Travel Tips for SNUB NOSED PETS

Snub nosed dogs and cats or brachycephalic breeds are often at higher risk during air travel than other breeds and special precautions are required before takeoff.



Snub Nosed breeds require a flight kennel at least 2 sizes bigger than other breeds.



 $_000$  Snub Nosed breeds may not share their flight kennel with any other pet, even if the flight kennel has additional space available.



Snub Nosed breeds may only fly in cool temperatures.

## Remember To:



Refrain from feeding snub nosed pets for 6-8 hours before flying.



Provide your pet with plenty of cool fresh water.



Dampen or mist their bed, mat or cushion. Alternitively, a cooling mat and pad will help keep your pet cool during their flight.
